### *The Mindo Birdathon*

Hoy member, Eric Howe, will highlight his trip to Ecuador this past August. The purpose of the trip was not only to see a lot of great bird species but also to raise money for the Mindo Birdathon, a fundraiser for the Mindo Cloudforest Foundation. The MCF is working to acquire critical bird habitat in the Choco Bioregion of Northwest Ecuador, home to over seventy-five endemic bird species (in addition to several hundred other species)



### Sunday, December 16, 2007 Racine Christmas Bird Count

The Christmas Bird Count, in its 108th year nationwide, has become a valuable method to monitor the winter range and numbers of bird populations throughout the decades. Join us in eastern Racine County as we go out on foot and by vehicles to count all the birds we see and hear. Birders will be assigned to territories within our count circles. There is a \$5 fee per person that is sent to the National Audubon Society to help Audubon defray their work on this project. There is no fee for feeder watchers and those under 18. ### Eastern Bluebird Nest Box Trails Successful in 2007

Four new Bluebird Trails were set up early this year in Racine and Kenosha Counties, thanks to collaborative funding from the National Audubon Society and the Bluebird Restoration Association of Wisconsin (BRAW). The trail locations include Sunset Ridge Memorial Park Cemetery in Kenosha Co. and Ives Grove Golf Course, Johnson Park Golf Course, and West Lawn Cemetery in Racine Co. Our appreciation go to these landowners. Thanks also go out to Rick Fare, Helen Pugh, John Raymond, and Stan Rosenstiel who helped installed and monitored these trails AND to Kent Hall from BRAW whose enthusiasm and visits from Steven's Point aided in placement/installation of nest boxes.

In 2008, we'll also have a new Bluebird Trail installed at Petrified Springs Golf Course in Kenosha Co. A thank you to Bob Stocks for the donation of nest boxes.

What were the results in 2007? A total of 130 Eastern Bluebirds had fledged as well as 126 Tree Swallows. Not bad for the first year!

**January 5 (Saturday) Lake Michigan Lakefront**

Join the Wisconsin Society for Ornithology at 8:00 A.M. at the South Shore Yacht Club in Milwaukee Co. Dress warmly and bring your "energy" foods. Directions to South Shore Yacht Club: take I 794 EAST over the Harbor Bridge. At the south end of the bridge take the Port of Milwaukee exit. The exit terminates at Carferry Drive (stop sign), turn left (east) on Carferry, continue east to a "T- intersection" with So. Lincoln Memorial Drive. Turn right (south) on Lincoln Memorial Dr. At the top of the hill the road curves right (west) and becomes Russell Avenue. After 1 block you will come to a stoplight at Superior Street; turn left (south) onto Superior and go 3 blocks to Iron Street. Again, turn left (east) on Iron, go 2 blocks and then down the hill into the parking lot, continue to the south end of the Yacht Club.
